Dr. Golder is Editor in Chief of Linacre Quarterly, journal of the Catholic Medical Association and the longest continuously published bioethics journal in the U.S. As a physician, attorney, bioethicist, and award-winning author, Dr. Golder also speaks and writes from her own frontline experiences and insight at the intersection of faith, law, medicine and ethics. Dr. Golder is a graduate of the University of Arizona (BS, Chemistry with honors); University of Florida (MD with honors), Stetson College of Law (JD, magna cum laude) and the National Catholic Bioethics Center (certificate with honors).
